Ruppiner Performance is a natural supplementary feed which, due to its nature, provides highly digestible energy without making the horses „hot“. A high proportion of vital substance-rich alfalfa as well as other stomach-friendly components, such as mucilage-rich extruded linseed, also make the product a very suitable feed for horses with sensitive stomachs. Due to the natural protein components, a high protein digestibility is achieved in order to support the muscles in the best possible way. In addition, weight loss can be prevented at the same time and the refeeding of lean horses can be optimally successful. Ruppiner Performance is suitable for heavily used horses of all use directions, breeding phases and for horses that are being built up. At the same time, it supports digestion due to the linseed it contains and provides important essential fatty acids. In order to do justice to the natural feeding of the horse, the feed contains only natural ingredients and is not additionally mineralised and vitaminised. This means that it can be added to any ration in the required quantity without affecting other components.

Feeding recommendation: Ruppiner Performance can be given with up to 60 - 160 g per 100 kg body weight and day in addition to roughage or concentrate. For a large horse (600 kg) this corresponds to 500 - 1000 g / horse / day. The feeding recommendation refers to a roughage intake (hay) of 1.5 kg per 100 kg body weight and day. Feeding can be done without soaking.

Composition: Lucerne green meal, linseed, extruded, wheat bran, extruded, rapeseed oil cake
Analytical ingredients and contents: 15.3% crude protein, 15.0% crude fat, 15.3% crude fibre, 10.0% crude ash, 1.0% calcium, 0.57% phosphorus, 0.06% sodium, 0.38% magnesium
